

RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA ON THE 12th DAY OF MAY, A.D. 2009.

WHEREAS, the study on recommendations on passive strategies for nitrogen reduction that complement use of conventional onsite wastewater treatment systems is yet to be completed; and

WHEREAS, completion of this study is crucial in protecting the Wekiva River and its contributing springs and potentially all environmental areas of concern throughout the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida budget for the upcoming fiscal year allows for the completion of the study with existing funding already designated from the current fiscal year in specific appropriation line item 471.




that the Board of County Commissioners urges Governor Crist to allow specific appropriation line item 471 to remain in the budget for fiscal year 2009-2010,
